



Third party liability insurance p.18

Not mandatory but strongly recommended!

- It covers damage you might cause to a third party
- Often required by accommodation providers
- Mandatory if you use a vehicle (including bicycles)
- About 15 CHF.- per month
- Often covered by your parents

- Respect the deadline for the registration (courses + exams)


