

PRESENTATION

The Diploma of Advanced Studies (DAS) in Entrepreneurial Leadership enables participants to improve their ability to manage a team through fair and effective leadership, namely to develop and innovate business that contributes to the evolution of the team members' career and increases all team members' employability. Participants obtain the DAS after completing two Certificate of Advanced Studies (CAS): the CAS in Entrepreneurial Management and the CAS in Responsible Leadership.

The CAS in Entrepreneurial Management provides innovators-to-be with the tools to identify and take full advantage of opportunities inside an existing organization or in a start-up.

The CAS in Responsible Leadership teaches future leaders the soft skills tools to maximize the engagement to their team(s).

AUDIENCE

- Managers seeking to boost their career and their employability by adding business development tools and entrepreneurial behavior to their skills
- Executives from major corporations liable to launch or manage a business unit or a company, or take over the management of a family business
- Engineers, doctors, or researchers who wish to improve their managerial skills and propel their ability to innovate

ASSESSMENT

Each module is subject to an assessment, including one or a combination of the following: in-class exam, classroom presentations, take-home assignments

DIPLOMA AWARDED

Students who successfully complete:

- The Entrepreneurial Management modules will be awarded the Certificate of Advanced Studies (CAS) in Entrepreneurial Management | 18 ECTS credits
- The Responsible Leadership modules will be awarded the Certificate of Advanced Studies (CAS) in Responsible Leadership | 18 ECTS credits
- The full program (36 ECTS credits) will be awarded the Diploma of Advanced Studies (DAS) in Entrepreneurial Leadership

Admission Requirement

A university degree or equivalent and at least 3 years of professional experience. Proficiency in English is required.

Programme Cost

- CAS | 6 modules: CHF 7,200.-
- DAS | 12 modules: CHF 13,100.-
- Individual module: CHF 1,700.-

Should participants who already obtained one of the two CAS decide to register for the DAS, the tuition fees that have already been paid for the first CAS (CHF 7,200) will be deducted from the total price for the DAS (CHF 13,100). The balance for the second CAS would thus be: CHF 5,900.
