



# MASTER IN INNOVATION, HUMAN DEVELOPMENT AND SUSTAINABILITY

#### **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

- **Bachelor degree** in various fields (including social and political sciences, economics, geography and environment, law, information technology, engineering and applied sciences)
- Certificate in English; minimum scores: **IELTS 6.5**; **TOEFL 79**; **TOEIC 720**; **Cambridge Advanced Certificate** (excepted for candidates graduated from a Bachelor taught in English and/or for candidates proving at least 2 years work experience in an Anglophone context)
- A strong interest in United Nations **Sustainable Development Goals** and in **contemporary China** and an experience in working and studying in **intercultural/international contexts**

#### **REQUIRED DOCUMENTS**

Applications must include:

- 3. Curriculum vitae (1 page A4).
- 4. Letter of motivation in English (1 page A4), which explains :
  - a. why the candidate wishes to follow this programme;
  - b. how the candidate is interested in the topics covered by Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs); in the processes of social, technical, economical or cultural innovation; and in contemporary China;
  - c. which track the candidate wishes to follow (Single Master or Dual Degree Programm)
  - d. which specialization (see study plan) the candidate wishes to choose and why.
- 5. Certified true copies (if not from a public Swiss university) of diplomas
- 6. Certified true copies (if not from a public Swiss university) of academic transcripts

- 7. Description of the most relevant courses and the study plan (if not from University of Geneva)
- 8. IELTS, TOEFL, TOEIC or CAE test results (if previous diploma not taught in English). For candidates from foreign universities, <u>English test results can be sent by April 30<sup>th</sup> (but the deadline for applying remains February 28<sup>th</sup>)</u>
- 9. Video edited by the candidate (max. 3 min.), answering the following questions:
  - a. Why have you applied for this Master?
  - b. What makes you a qualified candidate for this Master?
  - c. What do you want to achieve by taking this Master?
