

MacOS Printer installation for:

Canon imageRUNNER ADVANCE C5550i (Saleve Biochemistry Printer)

Canon imageRUNNER ADVANCE C5255i (Jura Biochemistry Printer)

1. Download the needed files from the local server:

2. Delete any old canon drivers by going to System Preferences → Printers and Scanners and delete using the minus symbol.

3. Add a new Printer by clicking the plus symbol. Click the IP tab.

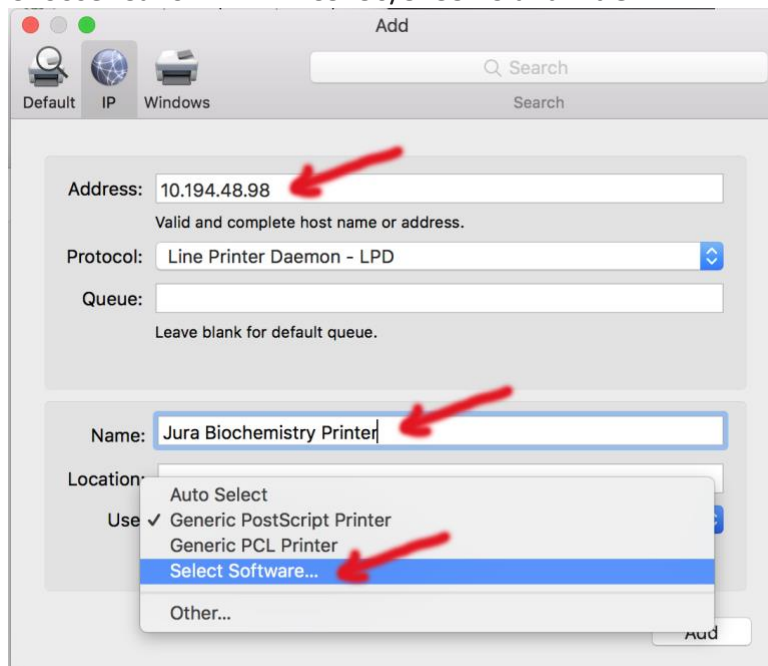
For the Jura Biochemistry Printer:

Choose: Canon iR-ADV C5250/5255 PS and hit OK



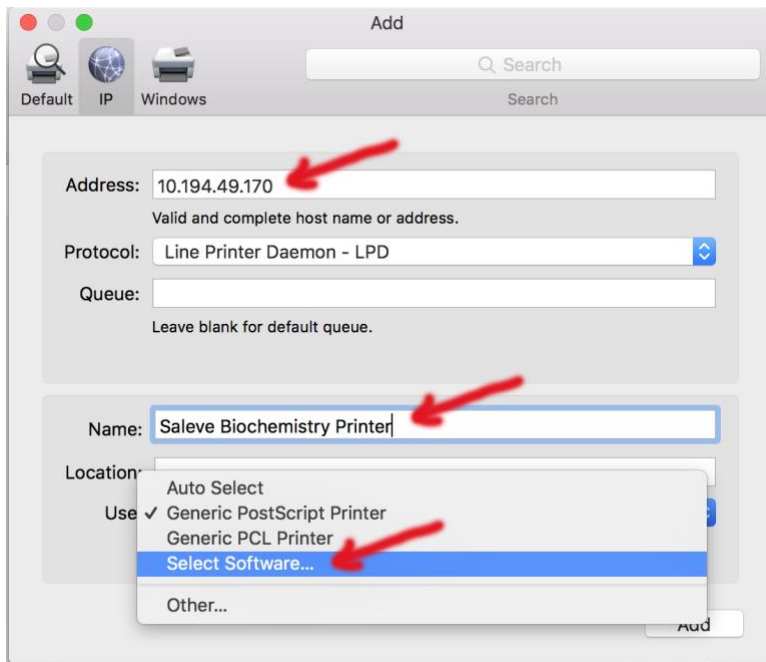
For the Saleve Biochemistry Printer

Click Use: and choose 'Select Software'.

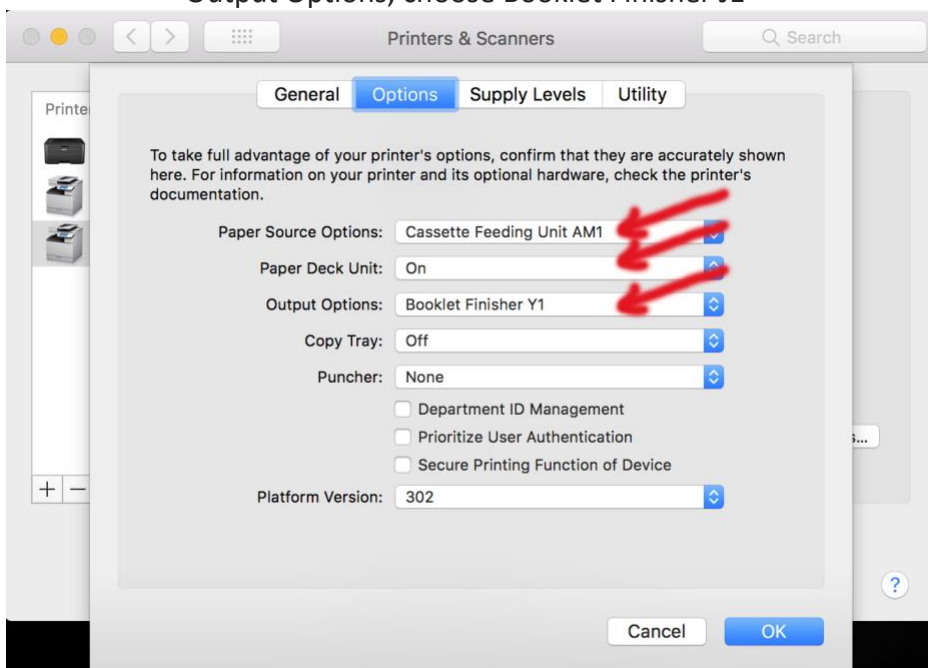
Choose: Canon iR-ADV C5550/5560 PS and hit OK

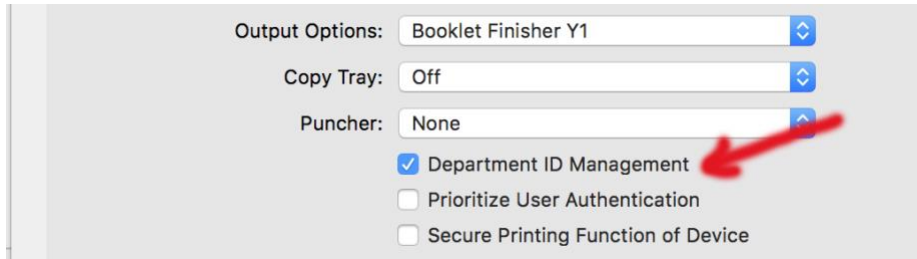


4. Turn on the necessary options (System Preferences → Printers and Scanners → Options and Supplies)



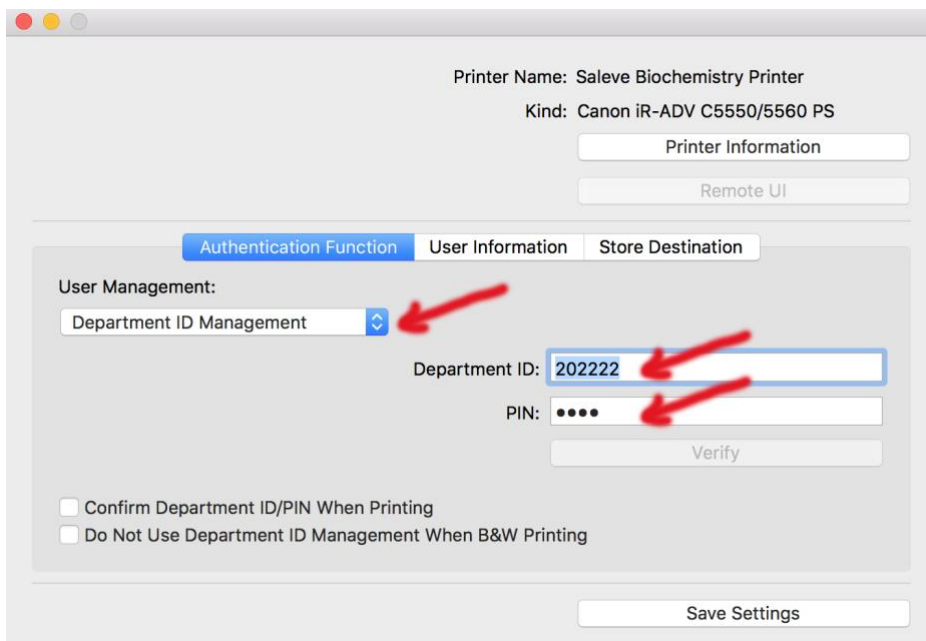
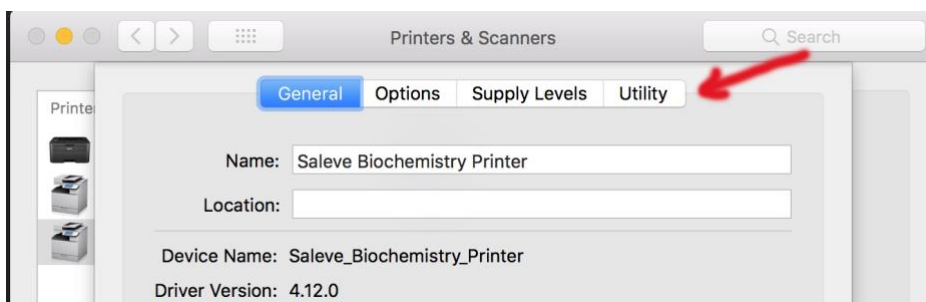
- Turn on Cassette Feeding Unit (either ON or Cassette Feeding Unit AM1)
- Turn Paper Deck Unit to ON
- Output Options, choose Booklet Finisher J1





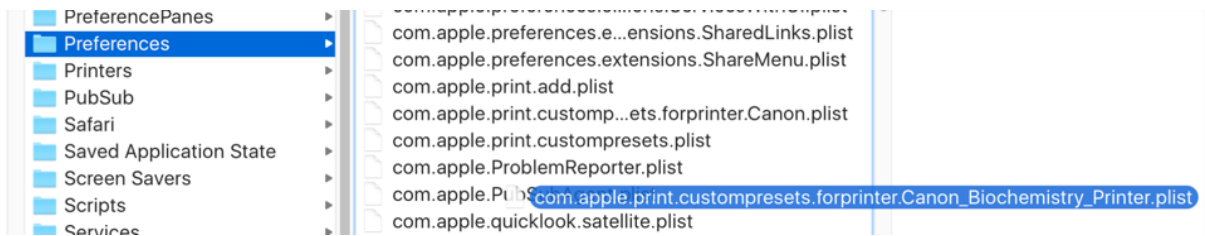
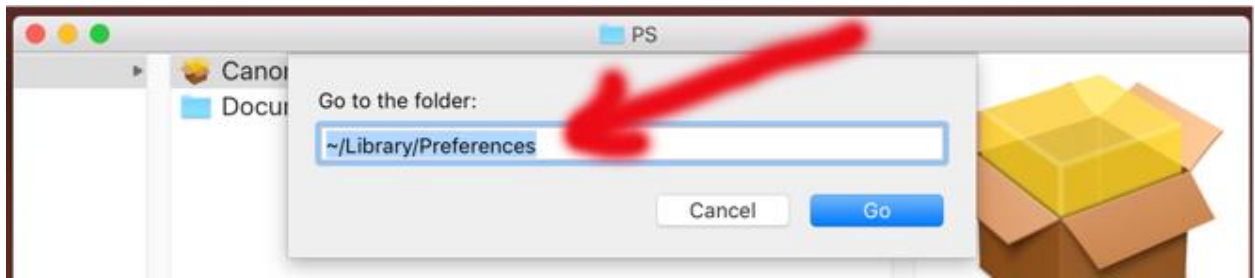
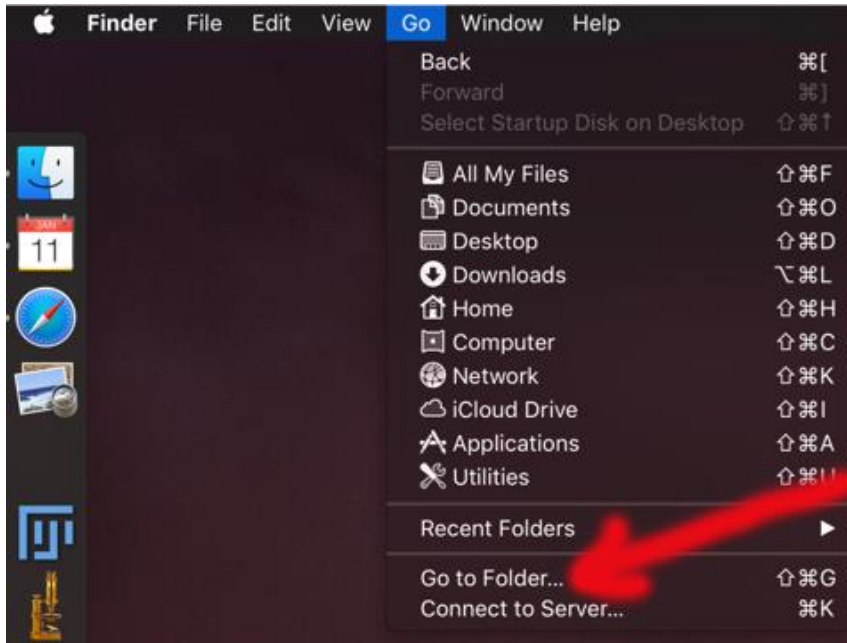
5. Add Dept ID info

- Select Dept. ID Management box
- click the Utility button -> Open Printer Utility
- Click or select Department ID Management
- Enter your Department ID and PIN and click Save changes

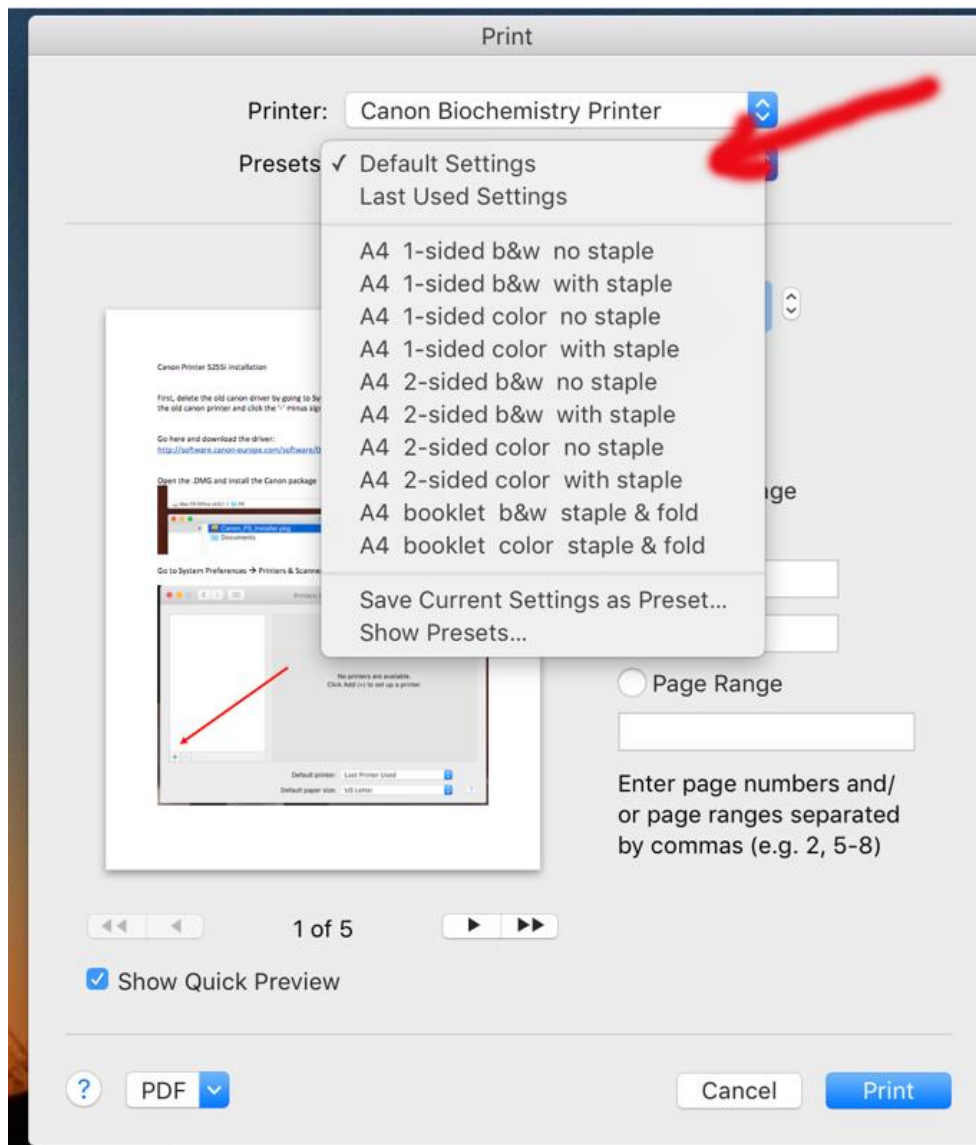


6. Install the Preset files

- Open Finder, click Go → Go to Folder... (or type: shift+cmd+G), and type or copy ~/Library/Preferences and click go
- Drag the preset files downloaded previously into the Preferences folder



7. When printing, click the Presets drop-down menu to access the presets. Sweet.



8. If you don't see the presets, you may need to go back to ~/Library/Preferences, and delete the old .plist of the printer using a previous name (10.194.48.98 for example).
