Short Profile C.G. Jung Institute Zurich, Küsnacht

- Since 1948, more than 1200 analysts have completed their diploma at the Institute
- More than 150 physicians have completed the three year psychotherapy training toward the specialist title in Psychiatry and Psychotherapy
- Currently more than 200 students in analytical and psychotherapeutic training
- Over 250 accredited analysts

Programs of the C.G. Jung Institute Zurich

- Four training programs
 - **Analytical Psychotherapy, federally recognized postgraduate title**
 - Psychoanalysis
 - Psychotherapy training toward the FMH specialist title in Psychiatry and Psychotherapy
 - CAS Analytical Psychology
- Three areas of specialization
 - Adults (E)
 - Children and adolescents (K)
 - Combined, adults, children and adolescents(C)

Programs of the C.G. Jung Institute Zurich

- Programs offered in both German and English
- German: Thursday, Friday, Saturday, part time
- English: Three times per year in a three week intensive block, part time
 - With students from all over the world
 - & With lecturers trained at the C.G. Jung Institute Zurich and external lecturers worldwide

Individuation

- As few prescriptions as possible, but minimum requirements for module categories
BAG guidelines, basic studies
- Flat rate program
- 64 courses in the German program SS26
- 108 courses in the English program SS26

Admission Requirements for the Federally Recognized Psychotherapist Title

- Master's degree in Psychology from a university or university of applied sciences with sufficient coursework in clinical psychology and psychopathology, 12 ECTS
- Or a completed degree in Medicine

Admission Requirements for the Federally Recognized Psychotherapist Title

- Written life history of 5 to 10 pages
- Description of key personal experiences and inner processes
- Engagement with conflicts, crises, or problems across life phases
- Encounter with Jungian psychology and motivation for training

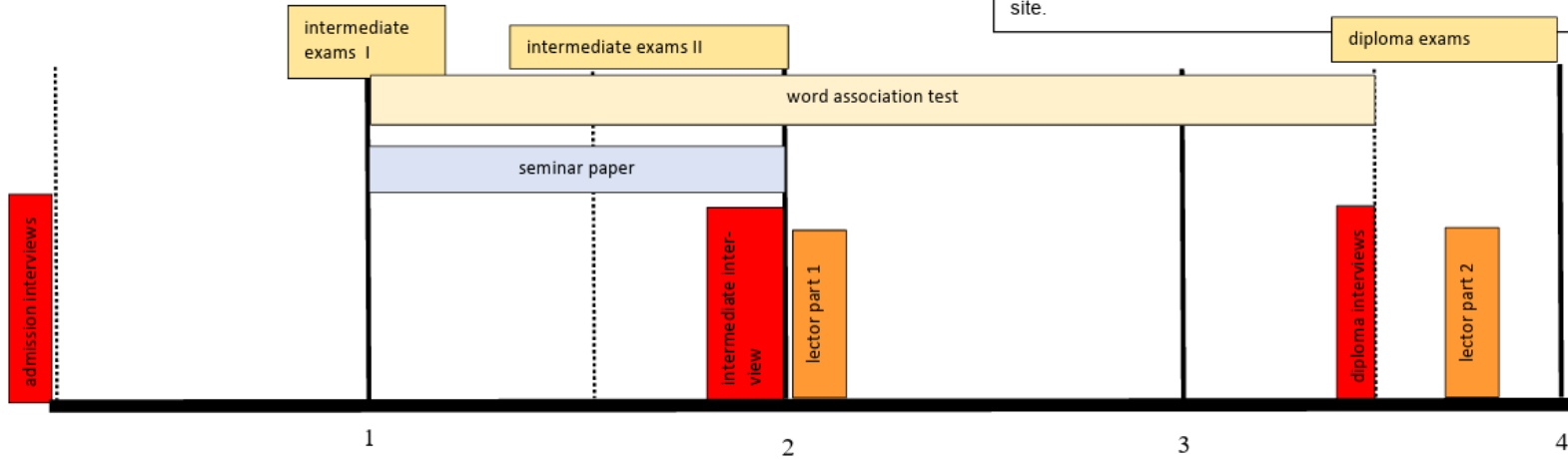
Admission Requirements for the Federally Recognized Psychotherapist Title

- Individual interviews with three members of the admissions committee
- Two one hour interviews with each member
- Total of six interviews

Self experience 37.5 sessions at CHF 130

Individual supervision 12.5 sessions at CHF 130

Total CHF 1625

Group supervision 17.5 sessions at CHF 50

Total CHF 875

Estimated annual total costs approximately CHF 15'000

Costs and Investment

- Semester fees are comparable to other institutes
- Higher total costs result from intensive self experience and supervision
- These elements are central to becoming excellent therapists
- International students allow cross subsidization
- Significantly broader teaching content and choice options than at most other institutes

Future Perspective

- Transitional regulations allow progression from the federally recognized psychotherapy title to psychoanalyst
- IAAP recognized psychoanalyst title
- Membership in a community of over 250 analysts
- Opportunities to become training analyst, supervisor, and lecturer and to develop specialized offerings
