WHAT ARE RESEARCH DATA?

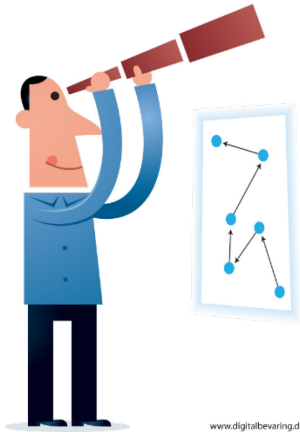
Factual records (numbers, text, images and sounds), which are used as primary sources for scientific research and are generally recognized by the scientific community as necessary to validate research results.

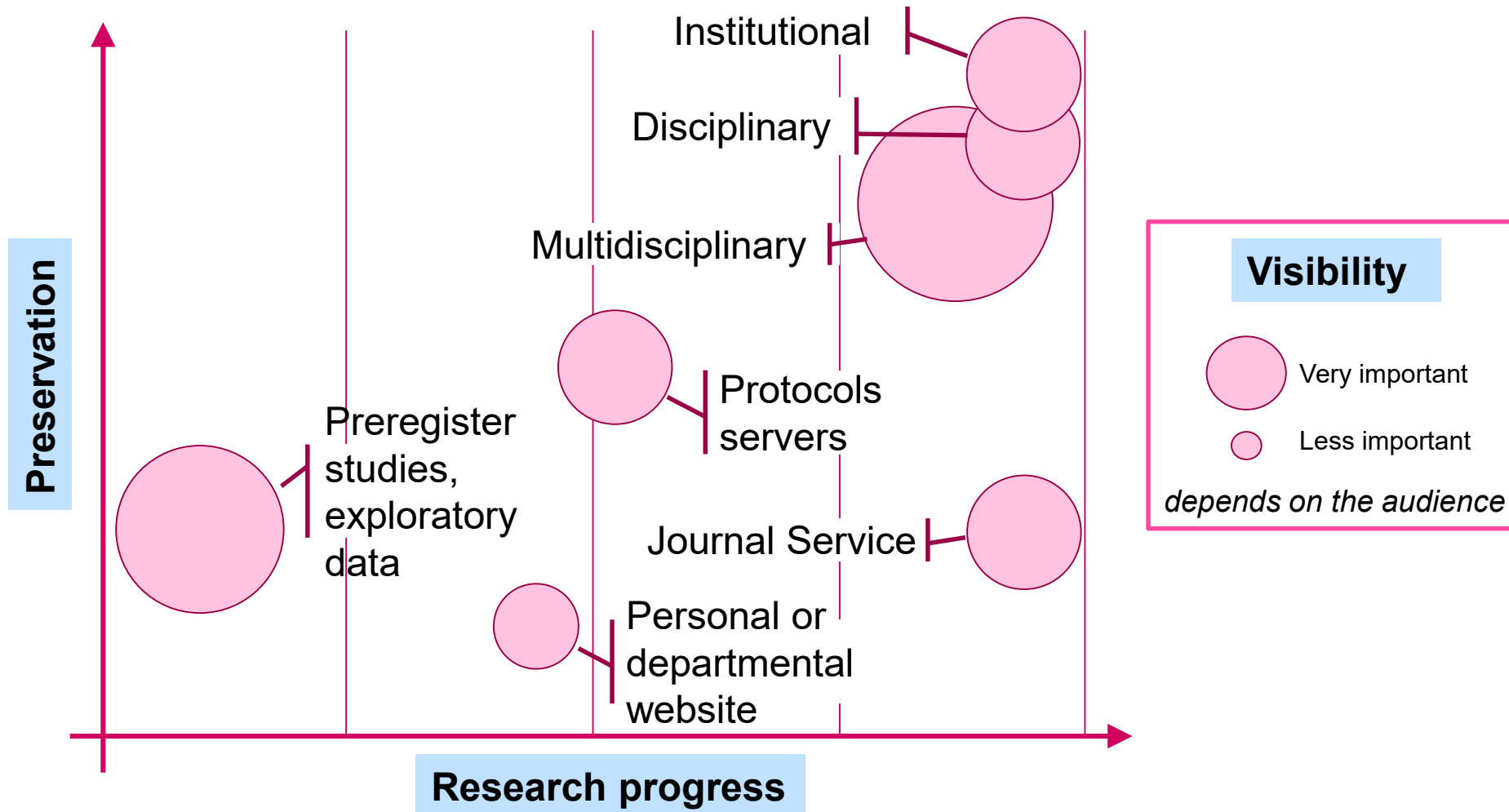


- ✓ General purpose (multi-disciplinary)

- ✓ Institutional



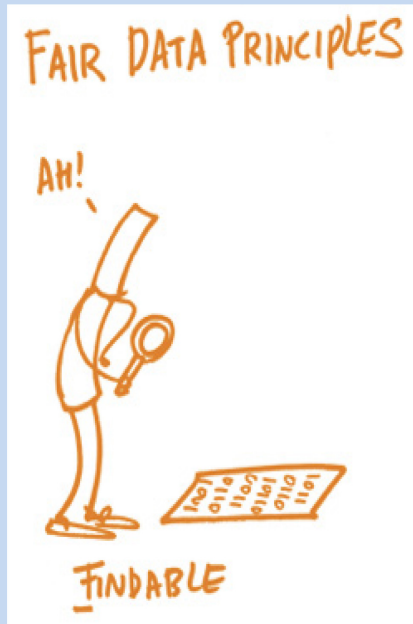
- 💣 Journal supplementary material service

REPOSITORIES' CHARACTERISTICS

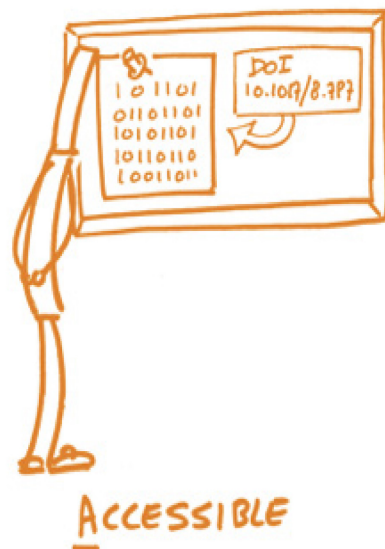


MAKE YOUR DATA FAIR

- ✓ persistent identifier
- ✓ enriched metadata
- ✓ Searchable and findable online



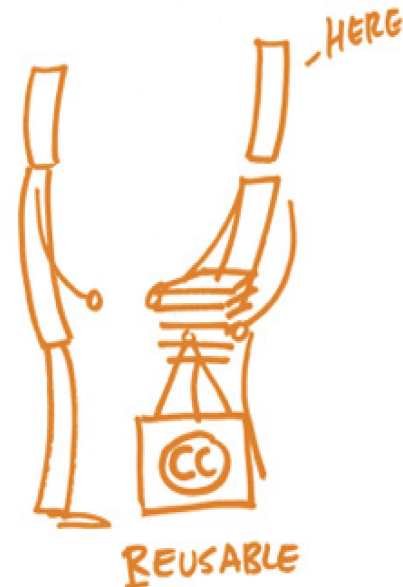
- ✓ retrievable using standard communication protocols
- ✓ possibility to define access rights

→ in a repository that ensures long-term preservation



- ✓ standard formats
- ✓ controlled vocabulary to describe data

→ data will be compatible and combinable with others



- ✓ well-described & documented (e.g. in a README file)
- ✓ clear conditions to cite and reuse data (e.g. CC licenses)

→ allow data to be correctly interpreted and reused

HOW TO FIND A REPOSITORY ?



Registry that indicates the characteristics of more than 2,000 repositories through a system of icons

IS MY REPOSITORY FAIR ?

Findable



At least one blue icon

Accessible



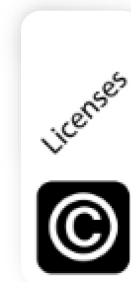
An orange icon with the lock

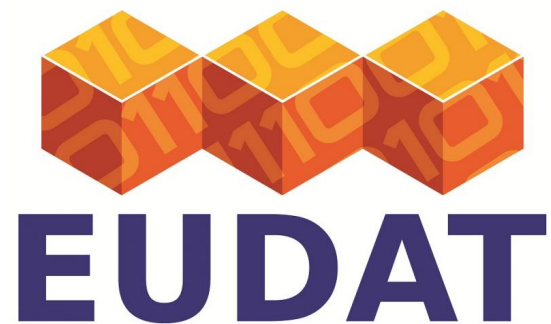

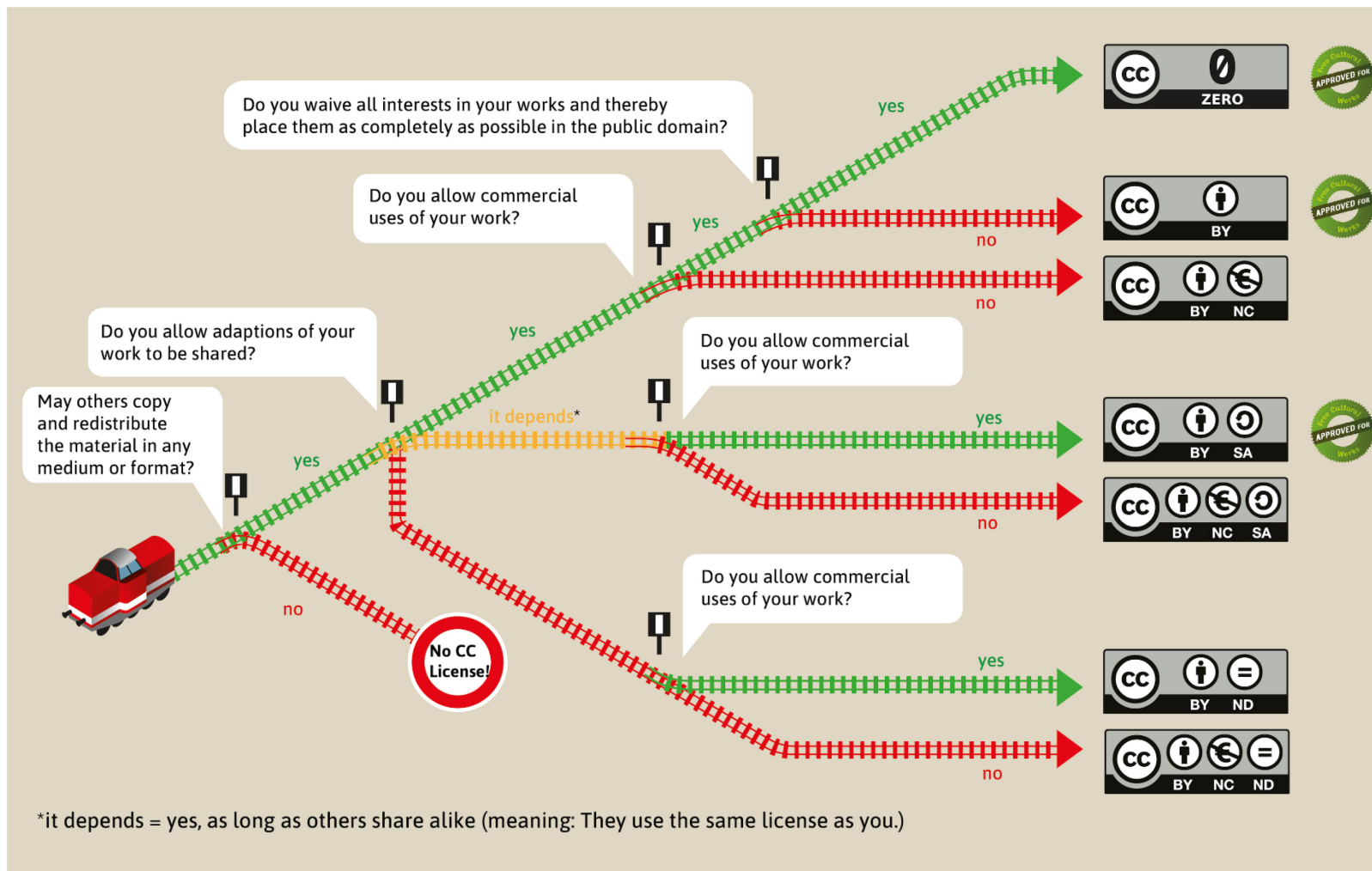

FUNDERS' REQUIREMENTS



FAIR repository

Has to be maintained by a non-profit organisation if you want financial support for uploading/preparing your data



FAIR principles



IN A NUTSHELL

Ideally, your repository should:

- ✓ be conform to the **FAIR** data principles
- ✓ be maintained by a **non-profit organisation**
- ✓ fits **your needs**
- ✓ ensures optimal **accessibility** and **visibility** to your data
- ✓ comply with your **funders' requirements**
