Research data management is framed by several texts:

- Open Science Charter


"Researchers manage and share their research data **as openly as possible**, so that they are findable, accessible, interoperable and reusable."

• Research Integrity Directive

"The head of the research project must ensure that the essential data are kept securely for at least **five years** after the end of the project."

A **team of librarians** will accompany you on-site and remotely through:

- training on various aspects of research data management;
- guidance on the selection of appropriate tools;
- support for using **Yareta**, the institutional tool for preserving and sharing research data;
- a proofreading service for Data Management Plans (DMP) required by funders and ethics committees;
- tailored support in case of specific needs.
