
Percentages of adults approving of physical punishment

Percentages of children experiencing physical punishment




Percentage of parents agreeing that . . .

Percentage of youth reporting that they had ever experienced various physical punishments








Trends in Attitudes toward Physical Punishment

Percentage of adults agreeing that there are certain circumstances when it is alright for a parent to smack/use physical punishment



Trends in Prosecution Rates


Police monitoring of 'minor' physical punishment reports

Issued a report every 6 months for 3 years (11 reporting periods)

Smacking	Open-handed slap to buttocks or legsNo injury		
Minor Act of Physical Discipline	 Open-handed slap to any other part of the body, including the face No injury 		




Smacking reports attended by police and prosecuted





MAPD reports attended by police and prosecuted





Method


• random sample of 1,000 parents in each country

• standardized questionnaire administered through face-to-face interviews
