

**Agnes Moors** is Associate Professor at KU Leuven and Associate Member of the Swiss Center for Affective Sciences. She combines theoretical work informed by philosophy with empirical research. Her theoretical work focuses on the comparison of emotion theories (see forthcoming book), the conceptual analysis of automaticity, the critical analysis of dual-process models, and the development of a goal-directed model for behavior causation. Her empirical work examines the role of goal-directed processes in emotional and suboptimal behavior using experimental behavioral methods (reaction time tasks, implicit measures) and neuroscientific methods (Transcranial Magnetic Resonance).
