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Legal frameworks applicable to water infrastructures built on transboundary water resources



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This thesis focuses on framing the States' rights and obligations towards other States, individuals, and stakeholders during the planning, construction, and operation of dams on transboundary watercourses. To define the applicable legal framework, it analyses international, regional, and bilateral legal instruments and case law examples, bridging international water, environmental, human rights, and humanitarian law to propose a roadmap for equitable and sustainable dam development that respects cross-border cooperation and protects fundamental rights.
