What is it?

An intensive French as a Foreign Language (FLE) course program provided in French at the University of Geneva.

Who is it for?

International students who have taken French at their home university and are in their 2nd or 3rd year of study.

What outcomes are to be expected ?

Reach and consolidate at least the B1 level on the CECRL scale.

What entry level is needed?

A2 level achieved, on track to B1.

You should be able to :

- Follow a class tailored to non-French speakers but given entirely in French.
- Hold everyday conversations in French
- Write simple emails in French



PROGRAM

What is the program's content ?

The ADI curriculum is organised in two units of French language courses and thematic courses in French. The program is held annually, beginning in September. It can be followed over a whole academic year or only one semester (typically the Fall semester, except under certain conditions)

Unit one

General language courses, e.g. "Writing-grammar", "Oral activities", "Pronunciation" (13 hours per week)

Unit two

Thematic courses on language, literature, and historical, social and cultural aspects of Geneva and the French Speaking world (5 to 7 hours per week)
