<u>Title: Evaluation of environmental impacts in water ecosystems guided sustainable water</u> resource management in developing countries; Case of sub-Saharan Africa. State of collaboration between University of Geneva-University of Kinshasa (Congo DR)

Since the year 2011, the Department F.-A. Forel for environmental and aquatic sciences (Institute for Environmental Sciences) of the University of Geneva advances in the interuniversity collaboration with the South countries, especially with the Democratic Republic of Congo Universities (University of Kinshasa and the National Pedagogical University).
