AUDIENCE

IO-MBA is designed for professionals who work for – or aspire to work for – IOs, NGOs, NPOs or Social Enterprise in managerial positions. Our alumni network counts over 250 leaders in diverse sectors from all over the world.

PROGRAM

The program is delivered full-time and part-time.

Full-Time MBA: 10 months (September to June) | 24 modules | 3-month consultancy in an IO, NGO or NPO | Master Thesis | 90 ECTS

Part-Time MBA: 2 or 3 years | 24 modules | Master Thesis | 90 ECTS

DIPLOMA AWARDED

Students who successfully complete the programme (90 ECTS credits) will be awarded the International Organizations MBA by the Faculty of Economics and Management of the University of Geneva.
