Expert academic translators are much in demand. This course aims to introduce professional French to English translators to the practice of academic translation and improve their skills.

Objectives

To improve knowledge of the French to English academic translation market and hone participants' academic translation skills.

Programme

The course will be taught online in English in twelve two-hour sessions. It will focus on building knowledge of the field as well as on practical exercises translating humanities and social science texts from French into English. Maximum course enrolment is twelve students, ensuring individual feedback and discussion.

Content

The course is divided into four modules:

- An overview of the market for French to English academic translation
- Practical workshops
- Nuts and bolts: dealing with quotations, references and bibliographies
- Funding, contracts, invoicing

In particular, it will cover the following issues:

- How to find academic translation work
- The key differences between French and English academic writing
- Funding opportunities for academic translation
- Professional translator status in France and Switzerland
- Rates and invoicing
