1. Course 1: Exploring Translation and Interpreting Studies — research questions and ethics (9 March - 17 April);

2. Course 2: Qualitative Methods — design and analysis of qualitative research (18 May - 19 June);

3. Course 3: Quantitative Methods — statistical analysis, survey design, and data interpretation (14 September - 16 October);

4. Course 4: Corpus Studies — compilation, analysis, and interpretation of corpora to explore linguistic patterns and translation phenomena (16 November - 18 December).

Participants will have access to reading materials, individual feedback, discussion threads and plenary lectures, and will be able to organise their work according to their individual schedules.
