PROFILE

Marlène Leroux is a founding partner, along with Francis Jacquier, of the architecture and urban planning firm Atelier Archiplein. Created in 2008 in Shanghai and relocated to Geneva in 2012, Atelier Archiplein has already established a solid reputation in the construction of natural materials, especially massive stones and wood, as well as urban renovations and interventions in the heritage arena. Alongside her practical activity, Marlène Leroux holds a doctorate in Architecture Science from the Ecole Polytechnique Fédérale de Lausanne. Before joining the University of Geneva as scientific coordinator of the MAS Urbanisme EPFL-UNIGE, she was a lecturer at the Institut d'urbanisme de Grenoble (IUGA). Marlène Leroux regularly participates in the EPF, HES-SO and ENSA (FR) and is a guest professor in the Massive Baukonstruktionen laboratory at the Technische Universität Dortmund. She also leads a multidisciplinary research project "cyclopean masonry", Innosuisse-Innovation Booster and is active in professional associations. Among others, she serves on the editorial board of the journal TRACÉS and is president of the executive committee of the Fondation Pavillon Sicli in Geneva.

The primary goal of this research is to undertake an analytical study addressing the urbanisation of rural areas as a major territorial, environmental and cultural challenge. The study focuses specifically on the urbanisation of China’s rural areas: a highly significant example in terms of both scale and contemporary relevance. Even though it was back in 2005 that the program of “building a new socialist countryside” in the 11th Five Year Plan placed the future of the rural sphere at the heart of China’s economic, political and social challenges, it is now, ten years on, that we can examine this project’s spatial and territorial implications and sustainable issues.
