Participants obtain the DAS after completing the CAS Leading within IOs and the CAS in Management Challenges in the Global Context (in any order).

- Master advanced management skills and practices applicable to intergovernmental, public and non-profit organizations
- Strengthen your skills in leadership, communication and team management
- Bridge the gap between corporate business and international cooperation and examine out-of-the box approaches

The program is designed for professionals who work for – or aspire to work for – IOs, NGOs, NPOs or Social Enterprise in managerial positions as well as professionals from the private sector looking for a career shift.
