




Credits



- ECTS credits: number of credits (3 or 6 ECTS credits)
- 1 ECTS credit represents approximately 25-30 academic hours (including studying hours)
- 1 semester = 30 ECTS credits



Prerequisite courses



Courses with a title in English are taught in English:


- "Financial Markets" is taught in English

Bachelor classes: You can answer during the exams either in French or English









Bachelor's students are not allowed to take Master's courses and the Master's courses in Commodity Trading and the mandatory Master's courses in Business Analytics are closed to exchange students.

Note:

Registration to courses = Registration to exams

Once submitted, the registration is <u>final</u> and cannot be modified.



How to register to courses and exams?

Be careful, in practice:

- 1. You will fill in the form online to submit your registration
- 2. You will receive, by email, acknowledgement of receipt.
- When your application has been **processed** by our Services, you will receive a confirmation with a link to access the decision (courses accepted and/or rejected).

Keep both emails:

- Acknowledgement of receipt = You have <u>submitted</u> the form
- Confirmation with a link = Courses acceptance/refusal decision



How to register for courses and exams?

- If you are a GSEM registered student (host Faculty) you can register for all courses with our form but at least 50% of your courses must be included in GSEM's Study Plans.
- If GSEM is not your host Faculty, please contact your host Faculty to know how to register for courses and exams at your home faculty. GSEM restrictions apply to GSEM courses.
- UNIGE regulation on Mobility states that you can only choose courses in 2 different Faculties.



How to register for courses and exams?

- Only for students who are staying the whole academic year (Fall + Spring semesters):
 - Online form for Fall Semester
 - Access to <u>GSEM Student Intranet</u> for Spring Semester

In both cases: deadlines to be observed



How to register to exams?

It is the same registration for courses and exams.

Fall Exam session: January 15 to February 3, 2024

Your **exams schedule** is available 3 weeks before the start of the exams session in the <u>window displays</u> at our Student Services.



Exams

- Grade at UNIGE : 0.00 to 6.00
- The minimum grade to acquire the credits for the courses is: 4.00/6.00
 As soon as you acquire the minimum passing grade (4.00), the credits are acquired and it's not possible to retake your exam
- The grade is given at 1/4 of point (ex. 3.25, 4.00, 5.75)
- The exams are offered in differents forms: writting, speaking, MCQ or Develop answer, etc.



In case of exam failure

- Mobility students are given two attempts to pass each course.
- ➤ If you <u>fail</u> one or more of your exams during the ordinary exam sessions (January-February or May-June):
 - ✓ You can retake the exam during the extraordinary exam session in August/September, but you are not obliged to do so.
 - ✓ If you wish to return to your university with one or more courses failed on your transcript and make arrangements with them, you can do so.
 - ✓ We do not expect a minimum of successful credits. For us, both successful and failed credits appear on the transcript.



In case of exam failure

- ✓ However, if you want to exercise your second attempt, you can do so but:
- You are <u>not automatically</u> signed up to retake the exam during the extraordinary exam session in **August/September**.
- To sign up, you must complete the <u>online form</u> on GSEM website by the stated deadline (<u>21 July</u>).

! At the University of Geneva, you can only take exams at the set place, time and date !


You cannot take exams remotely or at another time or date, and no exceptions to this rule can be made.






