Choose up to [three destinations](#) and rank them in order of preference.

Submit your [application online](#). Your application should include a provisional study plan ([Bachelor](#)/[Master](#)) with course descriptions for each destination. Please note that for destinations where courses are taught in English, [proof of your level of English](#) must be provided.

You will receive notification of your [preliminary acceptance](#) by email (at their “@etu.unige.ch” address).

This is an interfaculty selection process with multiple criteria, and the number of applicants is high. If your application is not accepted – or you do not get accepted to your chosen host university – you cannot challenge or appeal this decision.

Once your exchange has been confirmed, contact the [GSEM exchange adviser](#) and provide him with your complete file, your study plan and the course descriptions in order to have your study contract approved. You can also contact the adviser by email at [mobility-gsem@unige.ch](mailto:mobility-gsem@unige.ch).

## Please note

- Your study contract can be modified up to one month after courses start at your host university.
- If there is an overlap between the GSEM exam session and the start of the semester at your host university, please contact [GSEM Student Services](#).
- When you apply, you should have a grade average of at least 4.50 and are required to have a grade average of at least 4.00.
- You must obtain a grade average of at least 4.00 during the pre-departure exam sessions.
