



Equivalences

When?

Deadline to submit the request: 30 September 2023

How?

Form to be submitted on the **GSEM Student Intranet**, with justification

How many credits?

Max. 30 ECTS for 90 ECTS program Max. 40 ECTS for 120 ECTS program

Restrictions?

No equivalence for Master Thesis No equivalence for lower level of studies



Grading scale

- Based on 6.00 (0.00 to 6.00 with 1/4 of point)
- **4.00** = minimum grade to obtain (ECTS) credits
- If min. 4.00 obtained, no possibility to retake the exam to improve the grade
- If grade between 3.00 and 3.75, possibility to validate the grade (up to 9 ECTS) credits maximum
- ! Conservation of grade <u>not automatic</u>, must be submitted by the student according to deadline and process

Attempts

Core courses: 2 attempts maximum

<u>Elective courses:</u> 4 attempts same class <u>or</u> 2 attempts and, if failed only on 2nd attempt, change for another class



Exam sessions

2 Ordinary Sessions:

- January/February 2024
- May/June 2024

If absent, failed or excused; automatically registered for the retake session

1 Extraordinary Session (retake):

- August/September 2024

Co-requisites

- To be passed by <u>August-September 2024 at the latest</u>
- > For the co-requisites, a minimum grade of 4.00 is required.

Complementary Program

To be passed by <u>August-September 2024 at the latest</u>

Admin aspect:

- Register to course through <u>GSEM Student Intranet</u> (! not on the portail.unige.ch)



Duration of studies

90 ECTS Program : Min. 3 – Max. 5 Semesters

120 ECTS Program : Min. 4 – Max 6 Semesters

Courses and exams

Registration to courses = Registration to exams

Deadlines:

Fall Semester: 16 October 2024

Spring Semester: 11 March 2024

After these deadlines: no modification



Unforeseen event affecting your studies

Absence to evaluations

= Fail, except if sickness or accident

To be justified within 3 days, via GSEM Student Intranet

Duration of your studies

Leave

Derogation

To be evaluated by Scientific Committee, in collaboration with Academic Advisor, according to the Regulation

Cheating and plagiarism

Investigation and sanction if proven, according to the process

Master Thesis and Internship

Application Directive of your program to be consulted

To be submitted no later than 8 weeks before the end of the 5th Semester

Rules of behavior

Code of Ethics and Professional Conduct for the Geneva Institutions of Higher Education (<u>here</u>)



Elimination of the program

Less than 12 ECTS acquired by January-February 2024

Co-requisites courses / Complementary program not acquired by August-Septembre 2024

Definitive failed core courses

Deadline to submit master thesis or internship report not observed

Deadline to earn necessary credits (90 or 120) within the time limits



Mobility: Highlights of the 'Mobility Guidelines'

When?

From 3rd Semester

How long?

One semester = 30 ECTS credits max*. But be careful, it might differ from one program to another

Application file?

- Online registration from 9 October 2023
- Deadline to submit your application file (paper): 30 November 2023



*WARNING: subject to equivalences already obtained for previous university studies

Before the exchange...

Requirements?

Having <u>acquired</u>:

- ✓ If applicable, all co-requisites courses
- ✓ ECO: 30 ECTS credits of core courses
- ✓ MiRM : 30 ECTS credits of core courses
 - ! Choice between Internship and Mobility
- ✓ MASTAT : 18 ECTS credits of core courses
- ✓ GEMWEM : 36 ECTS credits (including 24 core courses of 1st part)
- ✓ MABAN (Research Concentration): 63 ECTS credits core courses of 1st year



Application?

- ➤ Please consult the website of <u>Academic Exchange Office</u> to know the required documents & the deadlines
- > Additional documents for GSEM students:
 - Provisional study plan
 - Detailed descriptions of the courses envisaged
 - Transcript of grades of last diploma

- Tip: keep a copy of your application form...

Study plan?

- Provisional when applying to Academic Exchange Office
- Once the destination is known, the study contract must be confirmed before the beginning of the stay

! The final attribution is conditional

- The Host University must accept the student
- The final study contract must be accepted by the GSEM Academic Advisor, in collaboration with the Scientific Committee

Validation?

The study contract must be prepared according to Mobility

JNIVERSITÉ Guidelines



During the Exchange...

 Amendment of the study contract? Possible until 1 month after the start of the semester at the welcoming university

After the Exchange...

- Delivery of the official transcript? To be provided directly by the welcoming university (not by the student!)
- Deadlines to submit the transcript? March 10, 2025, for validation on the February 2025 transcript
