How to register to courses and exams?

Be careful, in practice:

1. You will fill in the form **online to submit your registration**
2. You will receive, by **email**, acknowledgement of receipt.
3. When your application has been **processed** by our Services, you will receive a confirmation with a link to access the decision (courses **accepted** and/or **rejected**).

Keep both emails :

- Acknowledgement of receipt = You have submitted the form
- Confirmation with a link = Courses acceptance/refusal decision

How to register for courses and exams?

- If you are a *GSEM registered student (host Faculty)* you can register for all courses with our form but **at least 50% of your courses must be included in GSEM's Study Plans.**
- If *GSEM is not your host Faculty*, please contact your host Faculty to know how to register for courses and exams at your home faculty. GSEM restrictions apply to GSEM courses.
- UNIGE regulation on Mobility states that you can only choose courses in **2 different Faculties.**

In both cases: deadlines to be observed

*From **Monday 2 March** until **Monday 9 March** (8.00 pm)
at the latest (not before, not after)*

How is the academic calendar organized?

2 semesters :

- **Fall (A)** : 15 September 2025 to 19 December 2025
- **Spring (P)** : 16 February 2026 to 22 May 2026

3 exam sessions:

- 2 'ordinary sessions': **January/February** & **May/June**
- 1 retake session: **August/September**

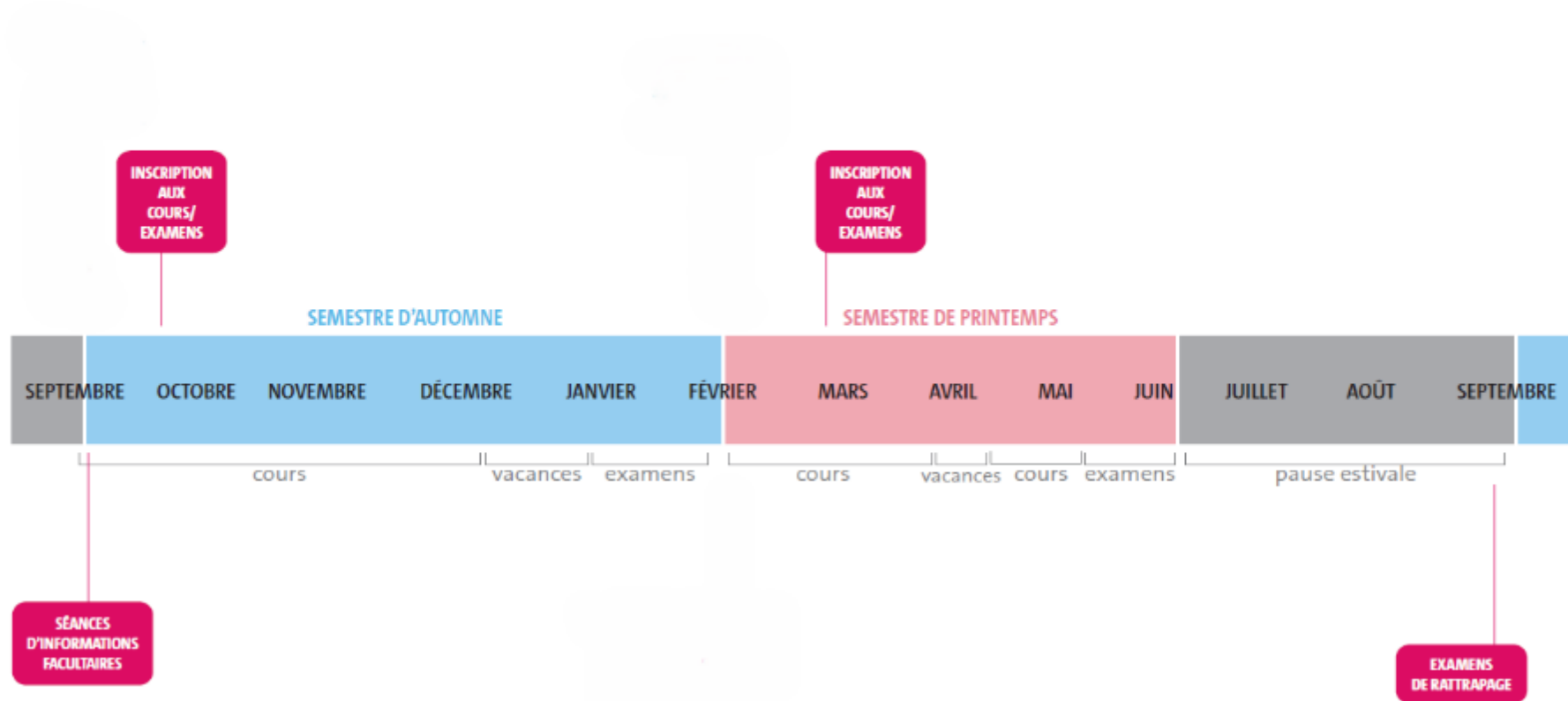

How to register to exams?

It is the **same registration** for courses and exams.

Exams

- Grade at UNIGE : **0.00 to 6.00**
- The minimum grade to acquire the credits for the courses is : **4.00/6.00**

As soon as you acquire the minimum passing grade (4.00), the credits are acquired and it's not possible to retake your exam
- The grade is given at **1/4 of point** (ex. 3.25, 4.00, 5.75)
- The exams are offered in different forms : writing, speaking, MCQ or Develop answer, etc.

In case of exam failure

- Mobility students are given **two attempts to pass each course**.
- If you fail one or more of your exams during the ordinary exam sessions (January-February or May-June):
 - ✓ You can retake the exam during the extraordinary exam session in August/September, but you are not obliged to do so.
 - ✓ If you wish to return to your university with one or more courses failed on your transcript and make arrangements with them, you can do so.
 - ✓ We do not expect a minimum of successful credits. For us, both successful and failed credits appear on the transcript.

In case of exam failure

- ✓ However, **if you want to exercise your second attempt**, you can do so but :
 - You are not automatically signed up to retake the exam during the extraordinary exam session in **August/September**.
 - To sign up, you must complete the [online form](#) on GSEM website by the stated deadline (**20 July 2026**).


! At the University of Geneva, you can only take exams at the set place, time and date !

You cannot take exams remotely or at another time or date, and no exceptions to this rule can be made.

This applies to all three exam sessions.
