Placement period	Ideally during the academic periods (autumn or spring semester) Also possible during the summer break (July and August). 2 months (min.) to 12 months (max.).
Placements available	Placements offer an opportunity to participate in the University's internationally leading research activities. Apply to any project of interest in participating Departments offered to LERU institutions. Placements are research only and it is expected they will be facilitated and funded under the Swiss European Mobility Programme (SEMP/ex-ERASMUS+).
Participating Departments	Projects will potentially be offered in all faculties (9) and interdisciplinary institutes.
Eligibility requirements	Placements available for undergraduate and Masters students currently studying at any of the LERU institutions participating in this scheme.

An invitation for an online registration will then sent to the student with all the documents required. The application is transferred to the supervisor for approval.
Participating LERU institutions	Lunds Universitet, Università degli studi di Milano, Université Paris Sud, Université Paris-Saclay, Universiteit Utrecht, University of Cambridge
Language used in placement	English (French recommended in addition; the exchange trainees can have access to a free French support courses during the semesters).
Language requirement	No formal requirement but all the trainees will be subjected to a skype interview with the future supervisor at the University of Geneva
Accommodation	The University shall assist students in finding suitable accommodation but this cannot be guaranteed and it will be the student's responsibility to make accommodation arrangements. Possibility to apply for university accommodation as exchange student/trainee. An high priority can be granted as STREAM/LERU trainee.
Estimated costs of living (housing, food, transportation, etc.)	Students should have sufficient finances for the duration of their stay in Geneva. The SEMP traineeship grant, if granted, is 420CHF per month and will not cover all the expenses. The approximate cost of living in Geneva per month is about 1800-2000CHF.
