Cette page web présente la bibliographie qui a servi de base à mon livre : *Américanisation. Une histoire mondiale (XVIIIe-XXIe siècle)* (Paris, Fayard, septembre 2020; <https://www.fayard.fr/>). Les références bibliographiques ont été compilées à l'aide du logiciel Zotero et viennent pour la plupart des catalogues de l'université de Princeton (<https://catalog.princeton.edu/>), de la Bibliothèque Nationale de France (www.bnf.fr), et du catalogue collectif suisse Rero (www.rero.ch). Les références d'articles viennent pour la plupart des portails de revues Jstor (www.jstor.org), Cairn (<https://www.cairn.info/>), Persée (www.persee.fr), Springer (<https://link.springer.com/>). Les références des articles et ressources web viennent des sites eux-mêmes.

Elle est organisée en 10 sections qui correspondent aux 10 chapitres du livre, à l'exception de la première. La bibliographie ayant servi à l'élaboration du cadre théorique n'a pas été incluse ici. On en trouvera les principaux titres dans le chapitre I du livre. En revanche, la première section de la bibliographie regroupe, entre autres, les ouvrages généraux. Chaque section est organisée en deux sous-sections : « ouvrages et articles » et « presse et ressources web ». Dans cette dernière, on trouvera des ressources électroniques, notamment toutes les sources mentionnés dans le livre, comme la Déclaration d'indépendance, le discours des 14 points et de nombreux autres textes ; mais également des documents récents produits par l'administration fédérale sous forme de page web ou de documents téléchargeables ; des liens permettant de visionner une partie des films cités ; des liens vers les sites de musées permettant de voir les œuvres mentionnées dans le livre ; des fonds d'archives donnant des indications sur des personnages ou des événements ; des articles de presse ou des ressources documentaires en ligne ayant servi à l'élaboration des pages portant sur la période la plus contemporaine ; et bien d'autres ressources documentaires qui seront utiles aux spécialistes, aux étudiantes et étudiants, et, plus généralement, à toute personne désireuse d'approfondir des questions abordées dans le livre.

L'ordre des sections est le suivant :

8. Production de masse et standardisation
