

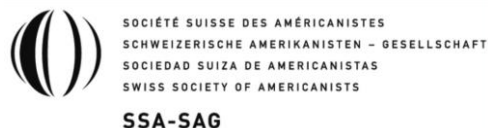
Thinking Through Latin American Studies
