

ATTENDANCE OF GTO SEMINARS

PROCEDURE FOR OBTAINING ECTS CREDITS

DOCTORAL PROGRAMME IN PHARMACEUTICAL SCIENCES

Doctoral students may be awarded **1,5 ECTS (European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System credits)** upon attendance at minimum **5 GTO seminars**, subject to compliance with the procedure outlined below.

To obtain ECTS credits, doctoral students are required to follow these steps:



1. **Refer to the [CRTOH website](#)** to consult the official calendar of the GTO Seminars.
2. **Declare their attendance to Sabrina Leroy or any other CRTOH representative** during each seminar attended.
3. A **certificate of attendance** will be issued and sent to the student in **June of the current academic year**.
4. The student is responsible for **transferring the certificate of attendance** to the School of Pharmaceutical Sciences administration (contact: progdoc-pharm@unige.ch).
5. The **Doctoral School** shall validate the award of ECTS credits **based on the number of seminars effectively attended**, in accordance with the applicable rules.

Credit Allocation (may be modified or revoked at all times upon decision of the PhD school) : attendance at **5 GTO seminars** entitles the student to **1,5 ECTS credit** / non-cumulative.
