Golden rules

Your bike you will lock

Don't forget to attach the wheel AND the frame to a fixed element.

In a shelter, the bike will be

A bike protected from the rain is a happy and healthy bike!

The highway code you will respect

Less chance of having an accident, less chance of getting a fine (if the police see you, of course)

On the right, you will ride

And if there's one, go to the bike paths and lanes:)

Cautiously, the tram tracks you will cross

Because we've all been fooled ... especially under the rain.



FAQ

What we do

What do you do, exactly?

We are a long term bike rental service (from 3 to 12 months). We are aimed at students, seasonal workers, and people from Geneva who wish to rent a bike for the summer (or winter, if that's your thing;)

We would like to offer a little more than just renting, that's why by renting a bike from us you benefit from services in other places completely free of charge!

We're also preparing other little things, but it's still «work in progess».

Do you have bikes for children?

We're slowly beginning! Don't hesitate to write us for more information.

Do you recover bikes (abandoned unused) ?

Yes, whether you are a private individual,

a management company or a municipality, do not hesitate to contact us. We recover abandoned bikes, refurbish them and then offer them for rent. We try to reduce the carbon footprint of our little blue planet as much as possible.

Rentals

I would like to rent a bicycle, how can I

Our opening hours are indicated on our website.Do not hesitate to visit us, and if you are absolutely unable to come write to us:)

What bikes do you offer?

La Bicyclette Bleue makes it a point of honor to reuse and recycle what already exists. So we rent used bikes, ranging from mountain bikes to road bikes. Check them on our website or on instagram.

FAQ

Why don't you open more often?

Although the Bicyclette Bleue is our little baby, we have busy lives alongside the organization and we all work on a voluntary basis. We promise to do what we can!

Where are your premises?

You will find us in the Jonction neighborhood, in the Ressources Urbaines complex. 3, Sentier des Saules.

The rental period is over. I would like to return the bike to you but you are closed. What to do?

It is indeed possible that we are not open the same day that the contract ends. In this case, we notify the tenant in advance to define the day of return of the bike.

Prices

What are the prices?

The base price is CHF 50 for 3 months, then add CHF 5 per additional month. According to our scholarly calculations, renting a bike for a year costs CHF 95.

Shouldn't I buy a bike, for this price?

If you are a bicycle addict, if you live for biking, if you use your bike all the time, then yes. However, if you are a temporary resident of Geneva, whether you are an intern, an exchange student, etc., it is rare and impractical to buy a bicycle, lights and a padlock for this price.

Why should I pay a deposit?

One day, bad intentions will no longer be part of this world. In the meantime, the Bicyclette Bleue has to make sure that smart kids don't try to steal our bikes by disappearing into the wild... that's why we have set up a unique deposit of 150CHF which assures us that the tenants

will give us back our bikes, locks and lights at the end of the rental period. In case of theft, loss or major damage, we withdraw all or part of the deposit when the bike is returned. If everything goes well, the deposit is fully refunded.

Can we pay by card?

For the moment, we only accept cash. Also think about the deposit;)

Repairs, damage and theft

Do you contribute to repairs?

If you received a damaged bike, please let us know as soon as possible and we will fix it for free. If the tenant for example rolled on glass or veiled a wheel with the skid of the century, it is the tenant to assume the repairs:)

My bike needs to be repaired ...

If you would like you can try to fix it yourself. If not, many places offer repairs at low prices. You will find all the repair

and self-repair locations in this booklet. Please note, if certain parts have to be repaired when the bike is returned, we can take back part of the deposit.

My bike has been stolen. What to do?

Oopsie! It happens even to the best. The first thing to do is to warn us, which will allow us to take action. If the bike is not found, we will take back the deposit of 150 CHF paid when renting the bike.

Formalities

What happens if I return my bike after the date stated in the contract?

- CHF 10 per day beyond a 48-hour delay
- the entire deposit beyond a delay of 14 days

FAQ

Am I insured?

When signing the rental contract, the lessee releases the Blue Bicycle from all liability in the event of accident or theft. By signing the contract, the lessee acknowledges that he/she has appropriate insurance in the event of an accident and that the bicycle he/she is renting is in perfect working order. It is therefore up to the renter to make sure that he/she is properly insured!
