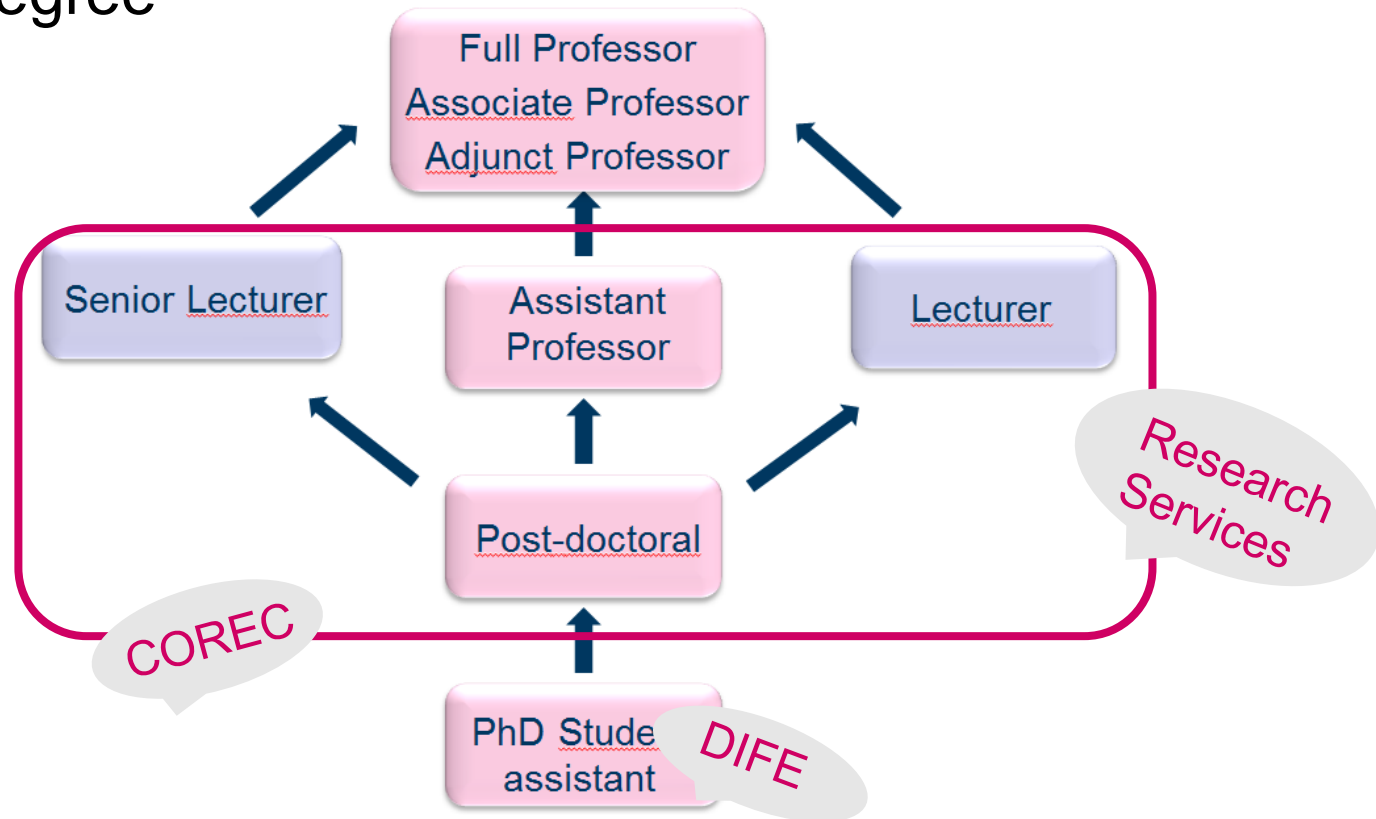

- Encourage young scientists and academics with a view to ensure that Switzerland has enough highly qualified professionals and to help strengthen the Swiss research
- The Swiss National Science Foundation (SNSF) is charged by the Confederation to support basic research and to encourage young scientists in Switzerland using public funds

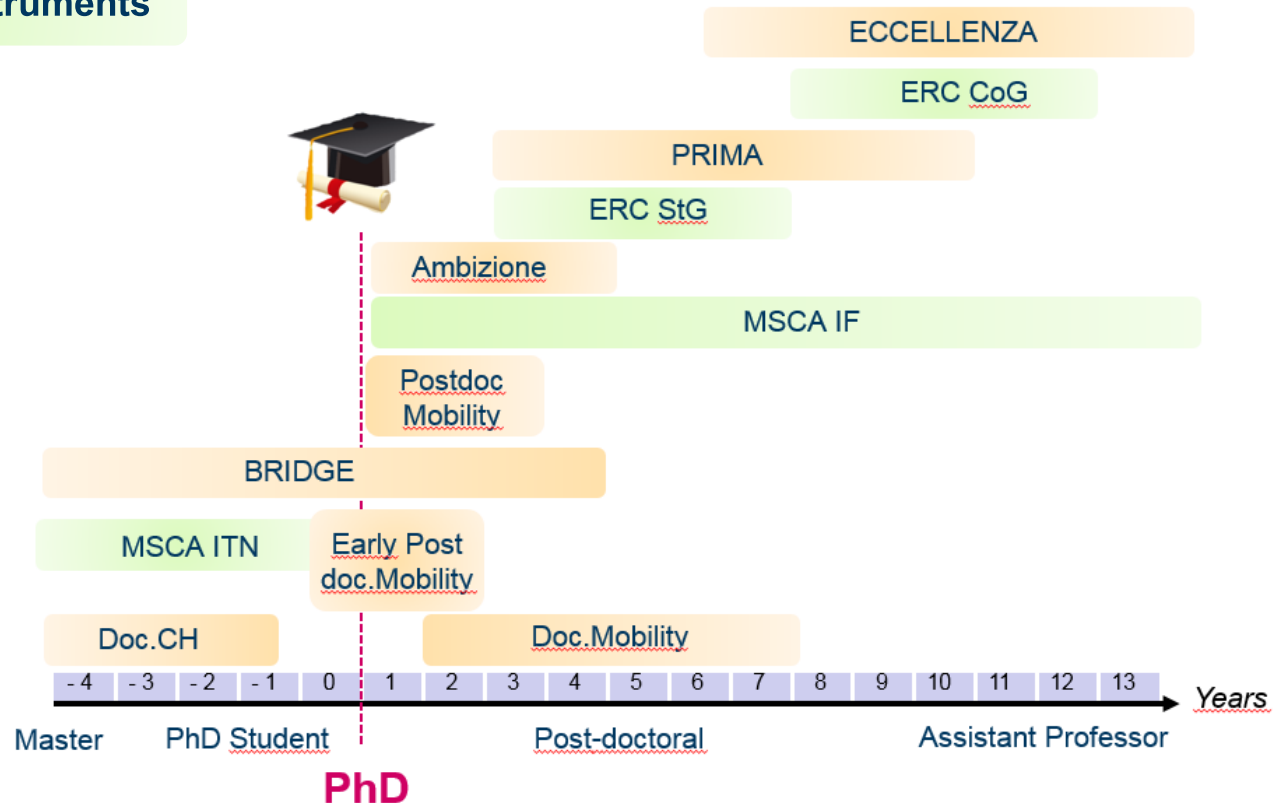

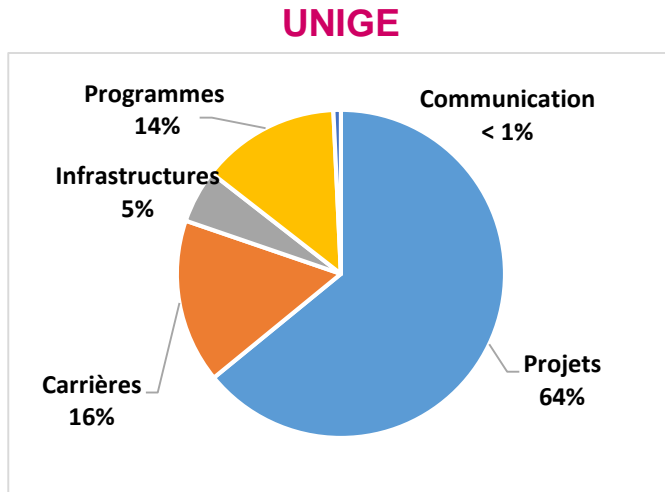

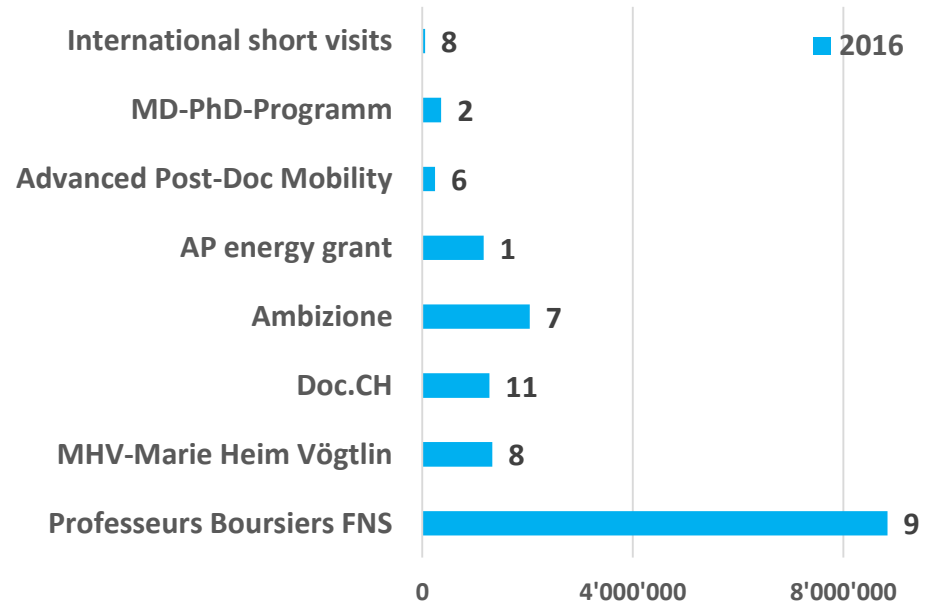

Ambizione

- Promote qualified researchers from Switzerland as well as excellent researchers from abroad



Ambizione project grant

- 400'000 CHF for 4 years (2 years min.) for project funds
(+ researcher's salary)

Ambizione grant

- Research activities >1 year after the doctoral thesis at a different institution
- All disciplines

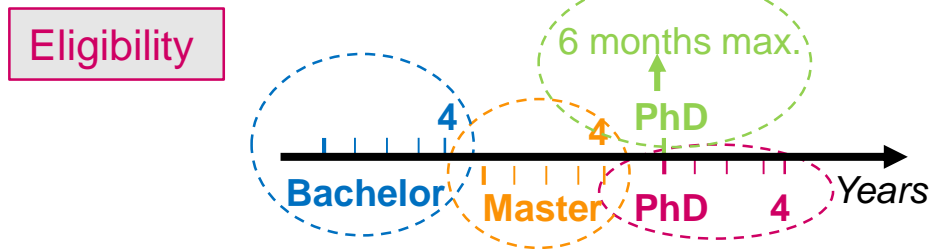

BRIDGE

- Joint programme conducted by the SNSF and the Commission for Technology and Innovation (CTI);
2 funding schemes: ***Proof of Concept*** and ***Discovery***

Proof of Concept:

- For young researchers: to develop an application or service based on their research results



- 130' 000 CHF for 1 year (extension once for a maximum of six months) for project funds + researcher's salary
- All disciplines

Submission deadlines for Proof of Concept projects

5th call: **11 December 2017**

6th call: **19 March 2018**

7th call: **04 June 2018**

8th call: **10 September 2018**

9th call: **10 December 2018**

PRIMA

- Excellent female researchers: an excellent track record in the research field and the ability to conduct the proposed research project independently



- 750'000 CHF for 5 years (2 years min.) for project funds + researcher's salary
- All disciplines

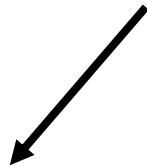

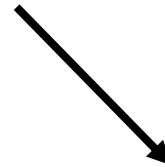

SNSF Eccellenza Professorial Fellowship

- Excellent researchers who have not yet won an assistant professorship



- 1'000'000 CHF for 5 years: researcher's salary + project funds
- Research stay > 2 years in another institution and > 1 year abroad
- Degree from a institution of higher education in Switzerland or at least 2 years' activity at a Swiss higher education institution
- All disciplines

NEXT SUBMISSION DEADLINE : 15 February 2018

SNSF Eccellenza Grants

- Excellent researchers who have recently been appointed as assistant professors with tenure track (APTT)
- 1'500'000 CHF for 5 years: project funds
- APTT: no later than the start of the project; & < 18 months, at the submission deadline
- All disciplines

NEXT SUBMISSION DEADLINE : 15 February 2018
