GENERAL INFORMATION

H.I.T. Program, High Potential University Leaders Identity & Skills Training Program – Inclusive Leadership in Academia, is an innovative, evidence-based and exclusive leadership program to specifically train and empower female professors in Switzerland to become university leaders. The H.I.T. Program 2021-24 is built upon the experience gained in the first national leadership program for female professors, H.I.T. Program 2019-20. All cantonal universities and the two federal technical universities are partners in the program, and the University of Zurich is the leading house.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

The H.I.T. Program is centered on skills and leadership identity training for female professors from all disciplines across Switzerland. The program is structured around training modules, individual coaching, professional networking, peer mentoring and leadership shadowing.

The H.I.T. Program 2023 is offered in blended format: 4½-day in-person sessions and one virtual session (½-day). Several **Training Modules** led by internationally well-known experts in academic leadership will be organized from March until September 2023 in Fribourg, St. Gallen, Bern and Basel.

In addition, as part of the **Personalized Leadership Development** component of the program, participants in the program will benefit from:

- Professional coaching: two individual sessions
- Leadership shadowing: one-to-one exchange with top leaders from academia (½-day)

Professional Network: Role models - female leaders from universities, federal agencies and bodies responsible for higher education and research policies - and change agents, will join in to discuss current issues in higher education in Switzerland. Our invited guests will also give practical advice and share from their leadership experiences to inspire the participants.

Overall, the participants will gain new knowledge and enhance their leadership skills, further develop their professional networks, and ultimately be prepared for senior academic leadership roles in the future.

APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Twenty places are available for female full or associate professors from cantonal and federal Swiss universities, who are interested in academic leadership positions at faculty- or university management levels.

Online applications: from 10 October 2022 until 6 November 2022.

Due to limited places, a selection process will take place. The participants, selected by the program selection committee with members from all partner universities, will be notified before 15 December 2022.

The registration fee for the participants in the program is 2'000 CHF, and includes access to all training sessions, course materials, lunches, coffee breaks, as well as dinner and accommodation for the 1½-day event organized in St. Gallen.
