

MASTER IN INNOVATION, HUMAN DEVELOPMENT AND SUSTAINABILITY – SINGLE DEGREE TRACK

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- **Bachelor degree** in various fields, including social and political sciences, economics, geography and environment, law, information technology, engineering and applied sciences)
- Proof of proficiency in English (for non-Native speakers): valid certificates and minimum scores **TOEFL 92**, **IELTS 7.0** or **Cambridge Advanced Certificate 185**, or Bachelor studies in English, or recent professional experience of 2 years minimum in an Anglophone context an attestation is needed
- Strong interest in the United Nations **Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)** and in any form of **innovation** (technical, economic, cultural and social) aiming at reaching the SDGs
- Experience working and studying in intercultural/international contexts

ENROLLMENT AND APPLICATION PROCESS

To apply for the Master program, candidates must concurrently:

- Apply for enrollment at the University of Geneva
- Submit their complete application file online on the G3S website

Application files must include:

- 1. Curriculum vitae (1 page A4).
- 2. Letter of motivation in English (1 page A4) explaining:
 - a. why the candidate wishes to follow this programme;
 - b. how the candidate is interested in the topics covered by the SDGs and processes of social, technical, economical and/or cultural innovation;
 - c. which track the candidate wishes to follow (Single Degree track or Dual Degree track)
 - d. which specialization (see the <u>study plan</u>) the candidate wishes to choose and why.
- 3. Copies of diplomas1
- 4. Copies of academic transcripts²

¹ The copies must be « <u>certified true copies</u> » if the University's country is not a signatory of the <u>Convention on the Recognition of Qualifications concerning Higher Education in the European Region</u>, aka the "<u>Lisbon Convention</u>" ² ditto



- 5. IELTS, TOEFL or CAE test results (except for English native speakers and other exceptions see Entry requirements above)
- 6. A **3-minute max**. video in which the candidate showcases her/his interest **beyond the letter of motivation**. Creativity is strongly encouraged; the only constraint is that the candidate her/himself must appear in the video for at least half the duration.

The video must be uploaded, in MP4 format exclusively, to an exchange file system (eq WeTransfer, Google Drive etc.) and the link indicated in the admission file. The link must be active at least 7 days from the date the form is submitted!

Applications that do not follow the above procedure or are incomplete will not be considered!
