

How to get there

The lectures take place at Université de Genève, building Uni Mail, Boulevard du Pont-d'Arve 40, 1211 Geneva In rooms MR040 (ground floor) and M1170 (1st floor). For orientation upon arrival, there is an info desk on the left side in the main hall of Uni Mail, and a map of the floor is displayed near the elevators on each floor.

From the airport

Take any train leaving the airport (every 10 to 15 minutes), all trains' first stop is Cornavin (Geneva Main Station) and it's a 6-minute ride. A free ticket machine is at your disposal near the exit of bagage claim, and all tickets issued there are valid for the public transportation trip to the university or your hotel (train + bus/tram).

From Cornavin (Geneva Train Station)

Tramway A 10-15 minute ride with tram 15 direction Palettes, leaving in front of the station. The ticket costs 3 at the machine (the machines do not give change unfortunately).

By foot If you wish to take a walk, it takes about 30 minutes via Bel-Air then Place Neuve and Uni Bastions and finally the Plaine de Plainpalais with Uni Mail.
