Modality of the study :

The participants are committed to respond to 8 interviews over the next 4 years. Each interview lasts approximately 1 hour and addresses the health and life conditions of the participants.

All information obtained will be coded to be **anonymous** and processed confidentially. It is possible to leave the study at any time.

Participation is on a voluntary basis and not remunerated. The participants will receive information regarding the health services available to them. This study will highlight the life conditions and needs of undocumented migrants in Geneva.
