At the beginning, the fight against doping worldwide lay with sport, state support was mostly subsidiary and limited to financial support.

Various doping scandals, however, led to the search for solutions in the fight against doping where sport no longer only monitored and regulated itself.

Today it is widely accepted that an effective and efficient fight against doping is only possible with targeted and scientifically driven testing programs, up-to-date analysis in the lab, a sound legal framework and interdisciplinary prevention and education.
