4-year post-doc position in Political Philosophy

The Chair in Political Philosophy at the University of Zurich is offering a Postdoctoral Position (80%), starting August 1, 2022. Duration: 2 years.

Duties: Conduct independent post-doctoral research in political philosophy; Publish in internationally visible journals; Teach 4h/week each semester (Spring and Fall Term, 14 weeks each); Support the Chair and Department in examinations, program promotion, organization of events.

Requirements: Ph.D. (Dphil) in philosophy (or political science with doctorate in political theory); Strong analytical skills, strong writing skills, strong teaching skills; Very good knowledge of English; IT-skills adequate for teaching and publishing in philosophy.
