EMERGENCY : ACTIVE SHOOTER

Direct or imminent threat from one or more individuals using weapon(s) and having injured or killed more than one person; the subject(s) is (are) still active and is (are) not under control.

1. Protect yourself (you and the students)

Avoid exposing yourself to gunfire at all costs!

	-
	If possible, lock yourself up and barricade yourself
In a classroom / auditorium, in an office	Turn off the lights
	Go to a safe area (move away from doors and windows and avoid exposure)
	Locate the danger to get away from it
Inside the building (halls, corridors, library)	Take cover and warn the people around you Depending on the situation: lock yourself up and barricade yourself or flee and take cover behind a solid structure (wall, pillar)
	As a last resort only, if possible: FLEE! Flee! Do not enter the building
Outside the building	Take cover
	Warn the people around you

2. Alert (warn occupants and call the police)

- Call 022 379 1222 (Campus security)
 - o Mention that an ACTIVE SHOOTER situation is in progress
 - o Give the location of the subject(s)
 - o If possible, give a description of the aggressor(s)
 - Provide information on the current situation (weapons shooting wounded etc.)
- Call 117 (police)

3. Manage (your group of students, if applicable)

	In order not to overload the network, prohibit the use of phones
	Mute ringtone and vibrator on all phones
You are locked up and barricated	Do not share information on the intervention of law enforcement
You are outside the building	Do not run towards the police and do not make sudden movements; keep your hands up and open

4. Wait and Follow police instructions

Do not take personal initiatives
